Room Parent

Room Parents are the connection from classroom teacher to parents. Teachers rely on the single point of contact to collect and distribute important communications/events that occur in the class. Room parents assist with parties, class art piece, teacher gifts, luncheon, and the yearbook page.

How can you get involved?

Coordinator:

Responsible for recruiting a room parent(s) for each classroom. Communicates to each classroom to put in an art piece for the Art Auction at Spring Open House. Assist with Teacher Appreciation Luncheon. Reports to PTO board regarding needs/timelines.

Room Parent Volunteers:

Set up communications for classroom between parents and teacher via Simply Circle/Yahoo Groups etc. Collect and manage donations from parents/guardians for classroom parties, teacher holiday/birthday gifts, and the Teacher Appreciation luncheon. Coordinate with teacher regarding classroom parties and gather parent help as needed. Create class/collage page for the yearbook. Recruit parent volunteers for Art or Science Vista as needed per grade. Some room parents run copies and stuff weekly envelopes. Attends (or sends class representative to) monthly PTO meetings.
